<p>To Men Making Men into Disciples</p>	<p>1. Start with a core team of men</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Recruit 2-5 men for the core team ● Pray for men in and out of church
	<p>2. Create a variety of relevant entry points</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Consider breakfasts, barbecues, sport events, service days ● Schedule equipping seminars for specific male needs ● Facilitate Bible studies and adult Bible classes for men ● Schedule an annual retreat/conference
	<p>3. Form small groups for men</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Identify and train small group leaders ● Determine subject, size, and type (closed, open, relational, and one-on-one).
	<p>4. Develop intentional followers of Jesus Christ</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Become men of prayer ● Study and apply the Word of God ● Deal with personal sin ● Operate under the Lordship of Christ
<p>Through Men Making Men Into Disciple Makers</p>	<p>5. Build men who lovingly lead in the home</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Date, relate, communicate, and pray with wives ● Start family nights and regular devotions ● Disciple the children ● Guard the gates of the home
	<p>6. Produce servants in the body of Christ</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Conduct gift assessments and provide understanding ● Actively engage men in a servant role ● Support the pastoral staff ● Demonstrate stewardship of time, talent, and treasure
	<p>7. Facilitate personal ministry to others</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Build friendships and find common ground ● Identify with Christ and share faith in Christ ● Mentor or coach another man ● Facilitate a small group or Bible study
	<p>8. Develop leadership in the local church</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> ● Impart spiritual disciplines ● Build ministry skill sets ● Promote sound doctrine and theology ● Develop godly character ● Demonstrate personal maturity
